

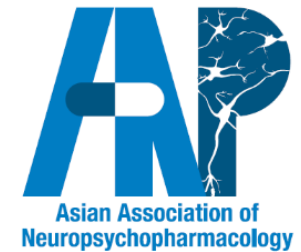


## ***Introduction of Asian Association of Neuropsychopharmacology (AANP)***

Hong Kong, hereinafter referred to as the “Society”

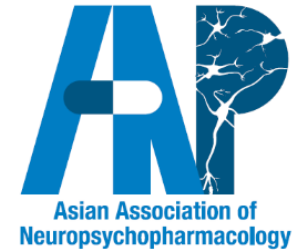


# Area Served
